



Vienna International Orchestra Conducting Masterclass

Vienna, Austria 5th – 9th February 2019

In February 2019, **Orpheus Kammerorchester Wien** and conductor **Konstantinos Diminakis** will hold a conducting masterclass in *Vienna, Austria*. The course will consist of lectures and demonstrations and conducting sessions for a maximum of 10 active participants. Sessions will include conducting 5 orchestral sessions, as well as piano rehearsals, leading to the final concert.

Final concert

A public concert will take place on the **9th February** during which all participants will conduct. The concert will be video-recorded and copies will be provided to all participants.

Participants will arrive in Vienna on the **4th February** and the course will begin on the following day. The concert will take place on the evening of the **9th February**.
